



# How to set up GFI Exinda AI

GFI Exinda AI helps you manage your network more easily by using artificial intelligence. With just a few steps, you can enable features that save time, improve performance, and make configuration much simpler, even if you're not a technical expert.

## What you need before you start:

- ✓ An existing GFI Exinda NetworkOrchestrator installation (version 7.6 or newer).
- ✓ Valid license that includes AI features.
- ✓ Internet connectivity in the management port.
- ✓ DNS configured in GFI Exinda.

## Setup steps

### 1 Update your GFI Exinda device

Make sure you're using the latest software:

- Go to **Configuration > System > Maintenance > Firmware Update** in your GFI Exinda web interface.
- Choose the option that best fits your needs (Install from URL, from downloaded file, from local file, etc.)
- Accept the terms and click **Install Image**.
- Restart your device when asked.

### 2 Check your license

- Go to **Configuration > System > Setup > License**.
- Make sure your license covers the AI features.
- If not, contact GFI or your usual reseller to get the right license.

### 3 Turn on GFI Exinda AI features

Make sure you're using the latest software:

- In the menu, go to **Configuration > System > Setup**.
- Find the **AI features** section.
- Turn on these options:
  - **AI Wizard**.
  - **AI Advisor**.

### 4 Check your license

- Go to **Configuration > Traffic Policies > Optimizer**.
- Click the **AI Wizard** button or icon.
- Type what you want in simple language (for example, "give zoom calls the highest priority").
- The system will show you what it will do, review and accept the changes.

### 5 Set up the AI Adviser (Smart suggestions)

- Go to **Monitor > Reports**.
- Find **AI Adviser** or **AI Reporting**.
